<p><b>Day 01</b></p> 	<p><b>Day of arrival to BATUMI</b></p> <p><u>Meeting and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation. Overnight.</u>          (Optional, for extra cost): <u>Night Batumi city tour</u> - Old Boulevard, Dancing Fountains, New Boulevard, Batumgora , night Batumi views (tour type: by bus, duration 2 hours)</p>
<p><b>Day 02</b></p> 	<p><b>BATUMI CITY TOUR and EXCURSION TO THE BOTANICAL GARDENS</b></p> <p><u>Batumi City Tour duration is 3-4 hours and includes visits to:</u> Batumi Seaside Park and Musical Fountains, Piazza Square, 6 May Park and Lake Nuriegel, Obelisk of Glory, Batumi Sea Port, Square of Arts, Adjara State Museum, New part of Batumi Seaside Park, Batumi Cathedral, Saint Barbara church, Orthodox Church of St. Nicolas, the Synagogue, Catholic Church, the Mosque, streets of Old Batumi, Square of Europe, as well as the ancient fortress museum-preserve of Gonio/Apsarus.</p> <p>After lunch: <u>Excursion to Batumi Botanical Gardens</u> (the 4<sup>th</sup> biggest botanical gardens in the world) can be considered as the visit card of Adjara. Its collection includes plants from all over the world and covers the territory of 112 ha comprising the following 9 phytogeographical departments: East Asian, North American, New Zealand, South American, Himalayan, Mexican, Australian, Mediterranean and Transcaucasia humid subtropics. Visitors are always particularly fascinated with the Gardens' 1200 species of rose.</p> <p><u>Return to the hotel. Overnight.</u></p>
<p><b>Day 03</b></p> 	<p><b>THE MOUNTAINOUS ADJARA</b></p> <p>Adjara is a region with ancient and fascinating history, beautiful nature and rich architectural monuments. With its unique flora and fauna, wild and ecologically clean environment, historical buildings and well preserved old-fashioned wooden houses hand-built by old masters Adjara highlands attract a lot of visitors every year.</p> <p>Among architectural sites that have survived to date in Adjara, particular attention should be paid to multiple-arch bridges that were similar in importance to fortresses and cultic sites. Bridge building traditions date back to the 4th-5th centuries AD. Today there are bridges mainly remaining in the valleys of the rivers Acharistskali and Kintrishi in Adjara the total number of which there is about 30.</p> <p>Lunch - taste traditional cuisine.</p> <p><u>Return to Batumi. Overnight.</u></p>
<p><b>Day 04 to 08</b></p>	<p><b>FREE TIME – SEASIDE VACATION</b></p>
<p><b>Day 09</b></p> 	<p><b>A DAY IN KOBULETI</b></p> <p><u>Drive to Kobuleti, a sea resort situated on the eastern coast of the Black Sea near Batumi.</u>  <u>Excursion to the historical site of the city-fortress Petra</u>, the ruins of which are located in the village of Tsikhisdziri, Kobuleti region. It dates back to VI c.AD. Historically this territory was the settlement place of one of the Kartvelian tribes – Lazes. The Byzantine Emperor Justinian built a city here because of the unique military-strategic and trade-economical location as the city was crossed by the essential road connecting Western Georgia, Byzantine provinces, Iran and Armenia.</p> <p>Full day to rest on the seaside in Kobuleti.</p> <p><u>Return to Batumi. Overnight.</u></p>
